*Applicants generally complete their postdoctoral training requirements within one year, however applicants may apply while completing their training, some applicants can take up to 4 years to

complete training requirements, and applicants may (or may not) receive a provisional license while completing training. Therefore, it should be noted that this report is not an adequate reflection of the Board's performance of the timely review or issuance of a license.

** A Provisional License is an interim license issued during the application process for Licensed Psychologist, this is not a separate application. Therefore, some of the numbers reflecting Licensed Psychologist issues may be duplicates or captured from applications for Provisional License.

1. **Provisional License Applications** completed by the 10th of any month, will be reviewed by the 20th of the same month for consideration of provisional licensure and early admittance to the EPPP. However, the application deadline for receipt of primary sourced documentation of passing EPPP and Postdoctoral documentation must be received according to the timetable above for oral examination scheduling.
2. **Licensed Specialists in School Psychology:** Applications are reviewed by the LSSP Committee which meets quarterly. Recommendations from the LSSP Committee are considered at the scheduled Board meeting in the following month or within 2-6 weeks.
3. **Temporary Registrations:** Completed applications are reviewed and approved by the Executive director within 10 business days.
