

**Louisiana State Board of Examiners of Psychologists**  
**LICENSED SPECIALIST IN SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY**  
**ADVISORY COMMITTEE**  
**MEETING MINUTES: June 26, 2018**

*Final Approved: September 25, 2018*

The Licensed Specialist in School Psychology Advisory Committee [herein Committee] of the Louisiana State Board of Examiners of Psychologists [Board] was noticed and agenda posted June 25, 2018. Dr. Carmen Broussard, called the meeting to order on June 26, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. at 8706 Jefferson Highway, Suite B, Baton Rouge, LA 70809. Present were Committee Members, Drs. Carmen Broussard, George Hebert, Amy Morvant, Ex Officio Member, Ms. Jaime Monic and future member, Ms. Stacey Johnson.

The committee recognized Ms. Stacey Johnson, welcoming her to the meeting and congratulating her on her appointment to the LSSP Advisory Committee to the LSBEP.

Dr. Hebert moved to approve the meeting agenda, the motion passed unanimously.

The committee reviewed the minutes from March 6, 2018. Dr. Hebert moved to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Broussard moved to enter executive session pursuant to LSA to conduct application file reviews. Dr. Broussard move to close executive session to offer motions on the matter. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Morvant reviewed the Application for Licensed Specialist in School Psychology of Anna M. Young Pardue, M.S. S.S.P. Dr. Morvant reported that the file was still being processed and not yet complete for recommendation.

Dr. Morvant reviewed the Application for Licensed Specialist in School Psychology of **Kandice A. Bateast, S.S.P.** Dr. Morvant, finding that the requirements for licensure have been met, moved that the Committee confirm the Candidacy status of **Ms. Bateast** and recommend her to the Board for licensure as a Specialist in School Psychology pending receipt of passing Jurisprudence Examination. The motion passed unanimously.

**DISCUSSION:**

1. Committee Updates: Dr. Hebert updated the committee with regard to the status the questions posed by the LSSP committee related to LSSP's providing supervision in a university training clinic to provide training to other LSSP's, advising the Committee of his telephone call with the board on March 16, 2018. Dr. Hebert explained that Board affirmed that an LSSP may provide internship and practicum supervision to graduate students in a specialist training program. This supervision would not count toward the postdoctoral training experience requirements for a licensed psychologist (doctoral level).

2. Confidentiality Agreements – The committee executed confidentiality agreements.

3. Chapter 42: Ethics for the LSSP – The committee discussed and continued to draft revisions to Chapter 42 (ethics) of the Louisiana Administrative Code.

Prior to adjourning, the committee recognized and gave commendations to Dr. Broussard for all of her work on the committee and being a pioneer to establishing the LSSP license.

Dr. Broussard moved to adjourn the meeting at 3:30 p.m. The motion passed unanimously.
