In accordance with La. R.S. 49:968(D)(1)(b), the Louisiana State Board of Examiners of Psychologists here by submits the following Summary Report and announces its intention to proceed with the publication of rules previously promulgated on July 20, 2021

Prior to formal publication in the Louisiana Register, the proposed rule was published on our website and licensees were noticed by email on February 9, 2021. The formal comments period was open through March 8, 2021. No comments were received, nor hearing requested related to this proposed rule amendment. Prior to filing the Notice of Intent with the Louisiana Register, the Board spent considerable time reviewing, discussing and offering opportunity for public comment on the Board's budget and proposed changes at their meetings in August, September, October, and November of 2020. No comments were received that were in


opposition to the proposed changes during these meetings where individual licensees and association representatives were present.

Additionally, this agency has appeared before the Occupational Licensing Review Commission (OLRC) for review of its Notice of Intent on January 7, 2021 and for review and permission to proceed with final Rulemaking on June 17, 2021. The OLRC moved favorably on both dates.
